# Terms and Conditions of Authorisation

- 1. The authorisation shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
- 2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised, by the prescribed authority.
- 3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
- 4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
- 5. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
- 6. The Unit will file the renewal application at least 2 months prior to the expiry of this Order

### Specific Conditions:

- 1. The Bio-Medical waste shall be segregated into containers or bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule I prior to its storage, transportation treatment.
- 2. The containers or bags referred to in sub-rule (2) shall be labeled as specified in schedule IV.
- 3. The occupier shall ensure that bio- medical waste generated in clinic is handled without any adverse effect to human health and the environment.
- 4. Bio- medical waste shall not be mixed with other waste.
- 5. If a container is transported from the premises where bio- medical waste is generated in any waste treatment facility container shall, a part from the label prescribed in schedule IV, also carry information in schedule IV.
- 6. No untreated bio- medical waste shall be kept beyond a period of 48 hrs. if it becomes necessary to store beyond 48 hrs. The authorized person must take permission from the prescribed authority to ensure that it does not adversely affect human health and the environment
- 7. The occupier shall submit an annual report to the prescribed authority in form IV by 30th June every year, to include information about the categories and quantities of Bio- medical waste handled during the preceding
- 8. This authorization shall be valid subject to the validity of agreement with the common Bio medical waste Treatment Facility. Renewed agreement should be submitted before the expiry of existing agreement.
- 9. The occupier shall maintain a record to the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and or any form of Bio- Medical waste in accordance with these rules and verification by the prescribed authority at anytime.
- 10. The occupier shall ensure the Mercury Spillage Management with in the clinic etc. due to breakages of thermometers, pressure & other measuring equipment as the spilled mercury does not become part of biomedical or other solid wastes generated from the health care facilities.
- 11. It is within powers and function of the U.P. Pollution Control Board to modify/revoke the terms and conditions of the authorization issued under the bio- medical waste Management Rules, 2018.
- 12. The occupier of the clinic is responsible to submit the information/record of valid permission issued by CMO and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility in case of failure to comply the provision of this conditional BMW authorization it shall deemed as cancelled automatically.





# The Terms and conditions of the contract are:

1. That the First Party is engaged in the activity of Nursing Homes/ Hospitals/ Pathological Laboratories/ Blood Bank/ Dental Clinics/Surgical Clinics/Private Clinics/Pharmaceutical Company, Veterinary Hospital etc atJhansi, Uttar Pradesh

That the Second Party is a Non-Government Organization with it registered office situated at H.O. 21, E Block, Kalpi Road Panki, Kanpur. B/O. G-23,4, Growth

Centre, Bijauli,

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- 3. That Bio-Medical Waste generated at the premises of the First Party is to be transported, treated and disposed off as per the norms of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Central Pollution Control Board and Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board by the Second Party.
- 4. That the Second Party will establish, run and operate Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility at G-2,3,4, Growth Centre, Bijauli, Jhansi Uttar Pradesh.

This plant shall have the following facilities as per "Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016Amended in 2018&19":

- Incinerator (Capacity 200 Kg/Hr.) Double chambered, automatic Italian Burner, PLC based panel, Venture Scrubber and 30m height Chimney.
- Online Emission Gas Monitoring System.
- Autoclave / Chemical treatment plant with a capacity of 800 Kg/Hr. with fully automatic controls.
- . Shredder.
- Sharp Pits/Encapsulation.
- Deep Burial Pits in case of any emergency.
- . Land for secured landfills.
- . Effluent Treatment Plant.
- Storage Rooms one for untreated Bio-Medical Waste and another for treated Bio-Medical Waste.
- \* Destructor Machine with Capsule for Cytotoxic Drugs.
- . Generator Room and Generating Set.
- \* Water Pump House.
- Laboratory for routine test.
- Disinfectant Tank to treat liquid Bio-Medical Waste.
- \* Washing Platform for washing of vehicle.
- Dedicated Closed Vehicles permitted by R.T.O. fitted with GPS.
- Maintenance Room cum office.
- Total Secured Land for land filling and plant building covered by boundary wall and fencing with guardroom.
- Provision of Fire Extinguishers, Fire Buckets and Fire Insurance.
- Green Belt and Fencing in and around plant.
  All Above are as per norms / standards prescribed by Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board /Central Pollution Control Board and Ministry of Environment and Forests.
- 5. That the First Party will ensure that the complete Bio-Medical Waste generated at its premises is properly segregated and handed over to the Second Party for transportation, Treatment and Disposal of Bio-medical waste. As per WHO survey, generation of the Bio- Medical Waste per bed is around 250-300 gms per but it will charge same up to 500 gms/bed/day. & second party will charge extra @ 40/- kg for yellow (Incinerable) and @ 8/-kg for red bags (Autoclable).

- 6. That the Second Party will pick up the complete Bio-Medical Waste generated at the Premises of the First Party.
- 7. That the First Party will ensure that neither will it dispose of any recyclable Bio-Medical Waste in the open market nor will it dump any of its Bio-Medical Waste in the Municipal Area.
- 8. That the Second Party will arrange material for Operation and Maintenance of the Bio- Medical Waste Treatment Plant and also for the disposal of the treated Bio- Medical Waste.
- 10. That the Second Party can verify the actual bed strength in the premises of the First Party at any point of time.
- 11. That the Second Party will also transport, treat and dispose of unclaimed dead bodies and still born babies after all the legal formalities for the above are completed by the First Party. (These will be collected inside YELLOW BAGS) with extra charges.
- 12. That the Second Party will start collection of complete Bio-Medical Waste from the premises of the First Party immediately after signing this agreement.
- 13. That the Second Party will be collected Bio-medical waste on every alternate day except Sunday & national holiday however waste generated on Sunday will be collected on the next working day.
- 14. That the Second Party will raise a bill for the monthly charges for transportation, treatment and disposal along with supply of handling material as per "Bio Medical waste Management rules 2016Amended in 2018&19' to the First Party by the 7th of succeeding month through a Crossed Cheque/ Bank Draft drawn in favour of M/s MEDICAL POLLUTION CONTROL COMMITTEE, payable at Jhansi CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY ANY WAY AND CONDITIONS.
- 15. That the Second Party may discontinue its services offered to the First Party, if the First Party defaults in payment of outstanding dues and matter can be referred to Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board /Central Pollution Control Board/Nagar Nigam for necessary action.
- 16. That the Second Party will charge 18% annual interest on the overdue outstanding dues of the First Party. The Second Party will start charging interest after the due date of payments.
- That the Second Party will carry out transportation, treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical Waste of the First Party as per the norms of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Central Pollution Control Board and Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and "Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016Amended in 2018&19". The Second Party will make necessary charges as and when required by the prescribed authority.

Medical Pollution Compail Committee

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- 18. That charges for authorization certificate from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board shall be borne by the First Party.
- 19. That the Second Party will give combined training to the paramedical staff of its member thrice free of cost. For any further training, the Second Party will charge Rs. 1000 per training session from the First Party.
- 20. That all disputes, complaints, suggestions etc. shall be referred to the advisory committee and its decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- 21. That the agreement is entered into for a period of Five Year.
- That if the cost of direct inputs for running the Plant increases, the charges for transportation, Treatment and Disposal of Bio-Medical Waste will be increased proportionally after the decision of the advisory committee.
- 23. That the Second Party will charge as per Annexure -I(Rates will be revised once in a year) irrespective of occupancy for Transportation, treatment and disposal charges from the First Party along with supply of handling material as per Annexure - II as per "Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016Amended in 2018&19". F
- 24. That the First Party will have to pay as extra Service Tax or any other taxes and levies as applied by the Government to the Second Party Presently there are no such levies.
- 25. According to the Government notification of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules 2016Amended in 2018&19, in excise of powers conferred by section 6, 8 & 25 of Environment (Protection) Act of 1986, the First Party and the Second Party will be working in accordance of all the norms stated in the notification, rules, directions and agreement.
- 26. According to the Government Notification of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules 2016Amended in 2018&19 responsibility of the First Party shall be for the part for which it has taken authorization from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and the responsibility of the Second Party shall be for the part for which it has taken authorization.
